A meeting of Board of Studies was held on 04.03.19 at 9.30 AM in the office of the Head of Department. Following members attended the meeting

At the onset, the Chairperson BoS welcomed all the members and thanked outside experts for sparing their time. The items were taken up as per agenda.

1. Agenda Item No. 1: To confirm the minutes of the Board of Studies meeting held on 13.07.18.

#### The member confirmed the minutes

2. <u>Item No. 3:</u> To consider and adopt the new curriculum for MBBS programme as prescribed by MCI. Dr. Surabhi Gupta informed all the members about the CBME based new curriculum for MBBS program introduced by MCI and is to be implemented from Aug 2019. According to this new curriculum there have been changes in the program outcome and the course outcome.

<u>PROGRAM OUTCOME</u> – New curriculum aspires to ensure that Indian Medical Graduates (IMG) meets global benchmark in knowledge, skills, attitude and communication. Various competencies have been framed subjectwise along with outcome that will define the roles of the IMG.

**COURSE OUTCOME** – The course of Pharmacology has been divided into 5 topics with 85 outcomes.

These topics are:

Pharmacology : 64 competencies
Clinical Pharmacology : 08 competencies
Clinical Pharmacy : 04 competencies

Experimental Pharmacology :

: 02 competencies : 07 competencies

AETCOM : 07 competence For each competency, learning objectives will be made.

3. <u>Item No. 4:</u> To consider running of value added course in the programme of Medical Sciences as per the annexure (As per Annexure-2).

Dr. Surabhi Gupta informed all the members about the value added courses to be introduced in the department of Pharmacology . The courses are as following :

A. Certificate course in Pharmacovigilance

- B. Subharti Diploma in Clinical Research
- C. Certificate course in Prescription Auditing

The goals, objectives, eligibility, time duration, registration fee and the details of the topics to be covered in these value added courses was discussed.

It was recommended to commence the value added courses. The members reiterated that such courses would add value to their employability and provide additional skills.
