

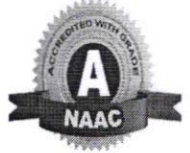

1. Dr. A.K. Srivastava, Principal & Dean, welcome all the heads and Medical Superintendent, CSSH. He informs to the house that Medical Council of India, New Delhi has developed a new Competency Based Medical Curriculum for undergraduate students and requested Vice Chancellor of all the Universities to implement it from academic session 2019-20. He asked



Dean Academics, Dr. Satyam Khare to present the salient features of new curriculum. Dean Academics informed the house that the classes will start with foundation course of one month from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019 in which student shall be exposed to Medical College and Hospital and their departments; skill lab; field visit to community health centre; professional development including ethics, enhancement of language and computer skill & sports and extra-curricular activities.

2. Dr. Khare informs that regular classes will start after one month from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019. The salient features of the course are vertical and horizontal integration among various courses; early clinical exposure from 1<sup>st</sup> Year, forensic medicine will be examined in 7<sup>th</sup> Semester and AETCOM modules for all the subjects. Minimum 50% of internal assessment marks are required to become eligible for appearing in the final examination but these marks will not be added.

3. Dr. Rahul Bansal, Prof. & Head, Department of Community Medicine discussed the details of foundation course and AETCOM modules.


4. Dr. Surabhi Gupta, HOD Pharmacology informed the duration of different subjects and assessment marks are also changed in the new curriculum. The duration of 12 months for Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry in first MBBS, 11 months for Pathology, Microbiology and Pharmacology in second MBBS, 12 months for 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS Part-I in which Forensic Medicine is added. After that two months allotted for elective postings and then 12 months for final year.

5. Dr. Mukesh Maheswari, HOD Surgery raised the question on horizontal and vertical integration. He said the student will not remember topics in final year which were covered in first year. Dr. Anita Pandey, HOD Microbiology, explained that by this method time will be saved which can be utilized for revision of course.

6. Dr. Saurabh Singhal, HOD Medicine, said when MCI recommended this curriculum as mandatory we have only option to implement it.

7. All the heads passed this curriculum in-toto.

8. Dr. A. K. Srivastava thanks all the heads and informed that this curriculum will be sent to Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for approval and to academic council for rectification.
