Dr. A.K. Srivastava, Principal & Dean, welcomed all the heads and Medical Superintendent, CSSH. The meeting stated with the confirmation of previous faculty board meeting dated 19.07.2018.

1. HOD Paramedical Sciences proposed amendment of syllabus in some courses.

- a) B. Sc. OT Technology 1<sup>st</sup> Year- Paper Code: BOTT-105 (Computational Skills and Biostatistics) - Change in syllabus as per the paper attached (**Annexure- 1**).
  - b) B. Sc. OT Technology 2<sup>nd</sup> Year- Paper Code: BOTT-201 (Applied Anatomy and Physiology) - Change in syllabus as per the paper attached (**Annexure- 2**), Paper code BOTT-204 (Medical Ethics and Research Technology)- Change in syllabus as per the paper attached (**Annexure- 3**).
  - c) B. Sc. MIT 1<sup>st</sup> Year- Paper code: BMIT-105 (Community Medicine)- Change in syllabus as per the paper attached (**Annexure- 4**).
  - d) M. Sc. MIT 1<sup>st</sup> Year- Paper code: MMIT-107 (Biostatistics)- Change in syllabus as per the paper attached (**Annexure- 5**).
  - e) M. Sc. MIT 2<sup>nd</sup> Year- Paper code: MMIT- 204 (Biostatistics)- Care of patients in Diagnostic Radiology and Management of healthcare organization (**Annexure-6**).
  - f) M.Sc. MLT 1<sup>st</sup> Year Paper code: MMLT-105 (Biostatistics and Computational Skills)- Change in syllabus as per the paper attached (**Annexure- 7**).
2. Amendment in name of B.Sc. MIT course into BRIT (Bachelor in Radiology and Imaging Technology)- The course is registered in UP State Medical Faculty as BRIT (Bachelor in Radiology and Imaging Technology ). The recommendation of Board of studies of Paramedical Sciences and consent of students is attached as **Annexure-8**.
  3. Amendment in the Ordinance no. V (71A) Chapter 6 regarding result of B.Sc. MIT to change in Pass percentage from 40% to 60%- Head Paramedical Sciences stated that to maintain the uniformity in examination of Paramedical Sciences. It is proposed that-
    - a) The pass percentage in subject of B.Sc. MIT is 50% and if student fails to secure 50% marks in not more than one paper, he/she will be provisionally promoted to the next year with carry over paper. They have to appear and obtain pass marks in carry over paper along with the subsequent regular examination for the relevant year.
    - b) If a student falls short of pass marks by not more than 5 marks in one theory paper, but secures pass marks in aggregate, he/she may be declared as pass at the end of the year by awarding grace marks, which however, will not be added to the aggregate.
    - c) A student will not be promoted to the next academic year if the carry over papers carryover papers are more than one at any point of time. The recommendation of Board of Studies is attached as Annexure No. 9.
  4. Amendment in the Ordinance No. V (73 A) Annexure – III (a) Chapter – 6, regarding Result of M.Sc. MIT to include one carry over paper- To maintain uniformity in examination in Paramedical Sciences it is proposed that:-
    - (a) If a student fails to secure 50% marks in not more than one paper of the academic year, he/she will be provisionally promoted to the next year with carryover paper will have to appear & obtain pass marks in carryover paper along with the subsequent regular examination for the relevant year.
    - (b) If a student falls short of pass marks by not more than five marks in one theory paper, but secures pass marks in aggregate, he/she may be declared as passed at the end of the year by awarding grace marks, which however, will not be added to the aggregate.
    - (c) A student will not be promoted to the next academic year if the carryover papers are more than one at any point of time.
 The recommendation of Board of Studies is attached as **Annexure No. 10**
  5. M.Sc. Molecular Biology & Biotechnology (MBBT): Head, CRS informed that The course is started in 2016-17 for 20 admissions per year but only 02 admission held till now in 2016-17. So it is proposed that the course may be closed for admission in 2019-20 sessions.

The course is reported in NIRF & AISHE data of this year. So it will be better to close this course in academic council meeting of May / June 2019.
