- Agenda No. 1:** **Confirmation of minutes of last faculty board meeting held on 30.12.2024**
Discussion & Resolution : Minutes were circulated to all the members and no comments were received. The minutes were passed, proposed by Dr. Vineeta Nikhil seconded by Dr. Pradeep Raghav & read as approved.

The Principal, Dr. Nikhil Srivastava informed that all departments have revised the curriculum for BDS and MDS programmes in 2023-2024
Following curriculum revisions were proposed by all Departments during discussion:

1) Oral Medicine & Radiology

a) In BDS final year Undergraduate examination, the theory paper shall include 2 short notes and instead of third short note- 5 fill in the blanks/one word answer questions will be given.

b) Two new topics will be introduced for UG teaching- **Phonophoresis and Lasers.**

2) Periodontology

a) More Lectures on Implantology

b) Lectures on Artificial Intelligence.

c) Pre-clinical exercise on Suturing

MDS Curriculum revision

a) Pre-clinical exercise- Sinus lift on Goat Head

b) Pre-clinical exercise on Endo-perio

c) Pre-clinical exercise on tooth preparation

3) Oral Surgery

BDS Curriculum Revision

a) Topics to be introduced for UG students- Artificial intelligence in Oral Surgery and Implantology.

b) MCQs to be inculcated in the curriculum at the beginning and end of the Clinical postings of both BDS third and final year students

c) BDS Final-year students will be sent to the operation theatre to observe surgical procedures and to acquire practical clinical training

- b) Publication within the posting should be completed & submitted.
- c) Practical application of SPSS/ Sample Size estimation/Clinical trial registry or Systematic review by each student.

5) Pediatric & Preventive Dentistry

BDS curriculum Revision

- a) Addition of one topic "Artificial intelligence in Pediatric Dentistry" for BDS students.

MDS curriculum Revision

- b) For MDS students, one-week posting of MDS First year students in digital lab.
- c) Two-week clinical posting of all the MDS students (on rotations basis) in the Department of Pediatrics, Subharti Medical College.

6) Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics

BDS curriculum Revision

- a) Patients' extraoral and intraoral photographs to be taken in the clinical posting by BDS 3rd and final year students.
- b) All interns have to make Night guard and Essix retainer for patients in their clinical posting.

7) Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge

BDS curriculum Revision

- a) Digital impression demonstration to be given to all BDS 2nd year students.
- b) Manipulation of RBIM (Resin Bonded, condensation and Addition Silicone)
- c) Demonstration of RMGIC (Resin modified GIC).
- d) Clinical demonstration on the use of impression materials for BDS 2nd year to be included.
- e) Use of lab scanner (Digital impression) for BDS final year students.
- f) BDS final year students will take clinical teaching twice a week under the guidance of respective faculty.
- g) Posterior typhodont preparations (on molars) to be included for BDS final year.
- h) BDS interns will do at least one posterior crown preparation on extracted tooth.

MDS Curriculum revision

- a) To make all PGs experts in operating CAD-CAM unit by giving them posting in CAD-CAM section twice a week.
- b) PG students to do 5 Maxillofacial Prosthesis cases before professional examination.

8) Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology

BDS curriculum Revision

- a) Field visit to be organized every year for BDS students.
- b) Lectures on "Artificial intelligence in Oral Pathology" to be inculcated in the BDS 3rd year curriculum.

9) Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics

- i) Artificial intelligence and its role in Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics (2)
- ii) Digital Smile Designing (2)

Additionally, External expert, Dr RK Gupta suggested that the Internal assessment of the students can be improvised by making it more unbiased. For the terminal examinations for BDS students, the theory answer sheets should be evaluated not only by the Internal examiner, but also cross-examined by senior Faculty members and then verified by the HOD of the Department.

Agenda No. 5 Discussion & Resolution:

To discuss the SOPs and proposed Value-added Courses for the Academic year 2025-2026.

The members discussed and appraised the SOPs for the proposed value-added courses for the academic year 2025-2026. Dr Vivek suggested that the VACs should be planned quarterly by the college. The Chairperson, Dr. Nikhil informed that Rashtrabodh as VAC, has been inculcated in the time-table of BDS-2025 Batch and the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) will be introduced from next session. The VACs list for 2025-26 is as follows:

- 1) Enhancing the clinical photography skill in dentistry (Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics)
- 2) Basic Life Preservation Training Programme (Oral Surgery)
- 3) Setting up a private/corporate dental practice (Oral Pathology)
- 4) Scientific Paper writing (Prosthodontics)
- 5) CBCT and CAD-CAM Integration for surgical stent designing (Oral Medicine & Radiology).

All abovementioned VACs have to be conducted before 31st July 2026.

The list will be sent to Academic Council for approval.

The principal informed that the QEWC in its meeting proposed the road map for the year 2026 and requested the Faculty Board members to ensure that each and every point mentioned in the road map should be completed by 31st December 2026. To organize at least one competitive activity for UG students by all Departments.

The Chairman proposed that all departments should organize at least one competitive activity for BDS students according to their specialty. For example, teeth setting exercises in Prosthodontics, suture techniques in Periodontology, cavity preparation in Conservative Dentistry, tooth carving in Oral Pathology etc. Certificates will be awarded to the winners in each category by all Departments.

Agenda No. 16:

Discussion & Resolution: Modification in Examination Pattern-

Misc. Agenda-

1. From 2025-26 session all the Practical/Clinical examination of the dental subjects will be conducted as per OSCE/OSPE Pattern. The aim is to evaluate clinical performance more thoroughly. Additionally the theory paper will also have very short type of question. (5 questions of 1 mark each).
2. Terminal Examination- At present SDC conducts 2 terminal examinations before university examination. Many a times, because of health reasons or other wise, few students are unable to appear in both the examinations making them ineligible to appear in final examination. It is therefore recommended that from 2025-26 session, SDC will conduct three terminal examinations out of which every student will have to appear atleast in 2 terminal examinations with minimum 35% marks, in order to qualify for the university examinations.
3. There is a lack of clarity whether the student shall be promoted to the next year if he/she fails in 1 subject in the supplementary examination. To clarify it, a letter was sent to Dental Council of India by the Principal, SDC and based on the reply, it is suggested that a clear cut guidelines regarding the above mentioned subject should be there in our university, “If a student is failed even in 1 subject in the supplementary examinations, he/she will be reverted back to the previous class and his period of the attendance during the provisional promotion to the next year shall be treated as null & void.
Note:- The above rule is already in force in Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka as well as University of Delhi.

In the end, Principal thanked all the members and experts for attending the meeting.
