



The Chairperson welcomed all the members and thanked them for giving their valuable time. The agendas were taken up and were discussed in detail with resolution.

Agenda Item 1 - Increase in Postgraduate seats
 Agenda 1 - Increase of Postgraduate seats in Departments of Medicine, Surgery, Obst &Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, pediatrics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Dermatology, Psychiatry, Respiratory Medicine, Anaesthesia, Radiodiognosis and Emergency Medicine.

Discussion – The Head of Departments of Pre and Para clinical said that there is no need to apply for increase of seats in these branches. Dr. Kiran Singh said as a large number of clinical seats are available in various Medical Colleges, so its very difficult to get candidates in branches like Physiology and Anatomy. Dr. Satyam Khare put the data in front of the house that since 2019 no PG candidate has joined in Department of Physiology, Therefore will not be advisable to increase seats in Pre clinical subjects. Dr. Anjali Khare told that seats of Pathology are completely filled but she added that it is gradually becoming difficult to fill the seats so applying for increase of seats will not be a good decision in Para clinical branches. Head of Departments of clinical branches said that they will go for increase of postgraduate seats in their respective departments as their all seats get fill up and are very much in demand. They said that the number of seats in their departments have been communicated by Board of Studies to principal office. Dr. Pradeep Bharti Gupta asked the Medical Superintendent about the work load, clinical material, etc. Dr. Minhas told the house that more & more camps will be organized to increase the work load and some schemes will also be implemented which will provide hospital services at discounted rate. This will help in increasing the OPD as well as IPD.
