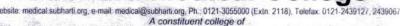

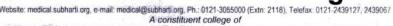

c) Agenda item No. 3: -

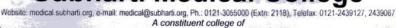
- Agenda Introduction of any new Value Added Course

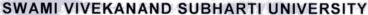
d) Agenda item No 4: -

- The members stated that a research proposal is already being conducted in the department and it shall be published as research article soon in an indexed journal.

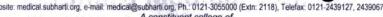

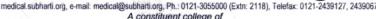
