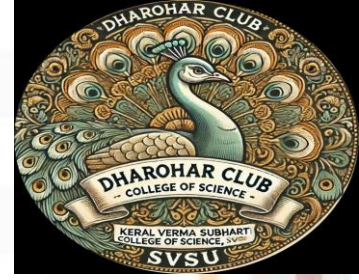

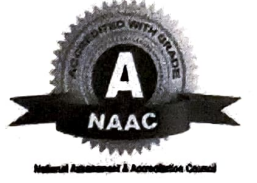

Ramayan – Mahabharat Quiz

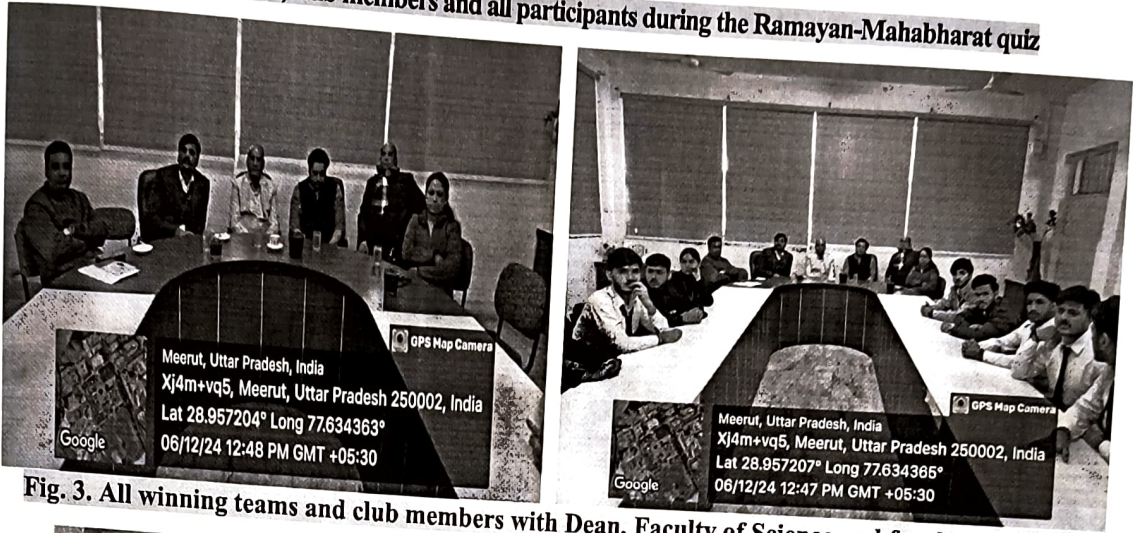


Fig. 3. All winning teams and club members with Dean, Faculty of Science and faculty members
