### Objective of the Activity

This lecture focuses on enlightening students about pharmaceutical industries premises, their day to day quality check process, cleaning schedule and their record maintainance and most importantly Drug Regulatory Affairs (DRA) regulation for manufacturing and maintenance of their Batch Manufacturing Records (BMR).

### Description

Pharma Care Connect Club has organized a lecture on 2<sup>nd</sup> National cGMP Day on 10/10/2024 to aware students about **“Think cGMP-cGMP is Quality”**. Total numbers of students actively participants were 127.

Ms. Priyadarshni Soni has a very interactive session with students and it helps them to enrich their knowledge about environment of pharmaceutical industries. Through this lecture they gain a

complete new insight about rules and regulation provided by Indian Drug Manufacturer's Association (IDMA) how to select and purchase Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient (API) and excipient, how to store them, how one can run quality control test, how the manufacturing and packaging is done and what an important role a quality assurance department play.

Activity was coordinated by **Dr. Mukesh Kumar**, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Pharmacy, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut and **Ms. Dimple Singh Tomar**, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Pharmacy, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut.

### **Outcome of the Activity**

Students got a new insight about different department which run parallelly and contribute to run pharmaceutical industries successfully. They got to know about Food and Drug Administration (FDA) rules and regulation which ensure quality of drugs manufactured, how to maintain data in Batch Manufacturing Records (BMR), how to set up pilot plants before beginning a manufacturing at large scale, which type of application one has to file for manufacturing a formulation like Investigational New Drug Application (INDA), Abbreviated New Drug Application (ANDA) and New Drug Application (NDA) application.

### **Analysis of Participant's Feedback**

- They got to know how to file and when to file Investigational New Drug Application (INDA), Abbreviated New Drug Application (ANDA) and New Drug Application (NDA) application.
- Students learn about basic operational process of different departments like Quality Control (QC), Quality Assurance (QA) and Manufacturing department.
- It enhances knowledge about the legal requirement to setup the manufacturing premises according to type of formulation intended to be manufactured

### Objective of the Activity

➤ Pharma Care Connect Club has organized a guest lecture on “**Sanitary Napkin Distribution Programme**” under the tagline Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana on 03 June, 2025 to aware Faculty members, students and Non-teaching staffs. 69 attendees have actively participated in the event.

1. **Improve Menstrual Hygiene Practices:** Ensure access to safe and hygienic menstrual products to reduce health risks associated with poor menstrual hygiene.
2. **Increase Awareness and Education:** Educate girls and women about menstruation, reproductive health, and hygiene management through workshops, counseling, and awareness campaigns.

- 3. Promote School Attendance:** Reduce absenteeism among adolescent girls in schools caused by lack of access to menstrual products or menstruation-related taboos.
- 4. Break the Stigma:** Normalize conversations around menstruation and help eliminate myths, taboos, and discrimination related to it.
- 5. Empower Women and Girls:** Enhance the confidence, dignity, and overall well-being of women and adolescent girls by providing them with the resources and knowledge to manage their menstrual health independently.
- 6. Ensure Accessibility and Affordability:** Distribute sanitary napkins at low or no cost to make menstrual products accessible to economically disadvantaged communities.

## Description

Mr. Rajendra Kumar Pushpad, Owner of Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Medical Store Meerut has encouraged the Faculty members, students and Non-teaching staffs to engage in talk the theme “**Sanitary Napkin Distribution Programme**” under the initiative “Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana”.

The *Sanitary Napkin Distribution Programme* is a health and hygiene initiative launched to ensure that adolescent girls and women, especially in rural, tribal, and underserved communities, have access to safe and affordable menstrual hygiene products. The programme is often implemented by government health departments, NGOs, and educational institutions in collaboration with local bodies.

Under this programme, **sanitary napkins are distributed free of cost or at subsidized rates** through schools, anganwadi centres, health camps, and community outreach programmes. The initiative is supported by **awareness sessions, health talks, and counseling** on menstrual hygiene, reproductive health, and the proper use and disposal of sanitary products.

Key components of the programme include:

- 1. Distribution of Sanitary Napkins:** Regular and easy access to good-quality sanitary napkins for adolescent girls and women.
- 2. Awareness Campaigns:** Conducting educational sessions to dispel myths, promote hygienic practices, and encourage open discussion on menstruation.
- 3. Training of Health Workers:** ASHA workers, teachers, and health volunteers are trained to spread awareness and distribute sanitary napkins efficiently.
- 4. Promotion of Safe Disposal:** Educating about environmentally safe methods of disposal, such as the use of incinerators or biodegradable pads.
- 5. Monitoring and Evaluation:** Keeping records of distribution, feedback from beneficiaries, and impact assessment to improve outreach and effectiveness.

Activity was facilitated by **Dr. Mukesh Kumar** and **Ms. Dimple Singh Tomar**, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Pharmacy, Swami Vivekanand Subharti University, Meerut

## **Outcome of the Activity**

The *Sanitary Napkin Distribution Programme* has led to several positive outcomes in the areas of health, education, and social awareness, especially among adolescent girls and women in rural and underserved communities. Key outcomes include:

- 1. Increased Awareness and Knowledge:** Educational sessions have helped break myths and taboos around menstruation. Girls and women are now more informed about menstrual hygiene and reproductive health.
- 2. Higher School Attendance among Girls:** The availability of sanitary napkins has significantly reduced absenteeism among school-going girls during their menstrual cycle, contributing to improved academic performance and retention.
- 3. Empowerment and Confidence:** Open discussions and awareness activities have helped build confidence and self-esteem among girls, enabling them to participate actively in school and community life.
- 4. Community Engagement and behavioral Change:** The programme has encouraged family and community members to support girls' health and hygiene, gradually shifting cultural attitudes toward menstruation.
- 5. Environmental Impact Awareness:** Through education on safe disposal, the programme has promoted eco-friendly practices and discouraged unsafe disposal methods.
- 6. Strengthened Health Systems:** Collaboration with ASHA workers, teachers, and health staff has strengthened community-based health outreach and monitoring systems.

## **Analysis of Participant's Feedback**

Participants of the *Sanitary Napkin Distribution Programme*, especially adolescent girls and women, have shared positive and impactful feedback reflecting the programme's usefulness and relevance. Some commonly reported feedback includes:

- 1. Improved Access and Convenience:** "Earlier, we had to manage without proper products. Now we get sanitary pads easily through school and health workers."
- 2. Better Awareness and Education:** "We learned a lot about menstrual hygiene, which was never taught to us before. Now we know how to stay clean and safe during periods."
- 3. Increased Confidence and Comfort:** "I used to stay at home during my periods. Now I go to school regularly and feel more confident."
- 4. Positive School Environment:** "Teachers and health workers talk openly about menstruation now. It has reduced our shyness and fear."

5. **Support from Health Workers:** “ASHA didis are helpful and explain things clearly. They make us feel comfortable asking questions.”
6. **Demand for Regular Supply:** “Sometimes the supply of pads is irregular. We hope the programme continues and we get enough every month.”
7. **Suggestions for Improvement:** “The quality of pads could be better and disposal methods should be improved. Also, boys should also be educated to reduce teasing.”
8. **Gratitude for Inclusion:** “Thank you for thinking about our needs. This programme has made a big difference in our lives.





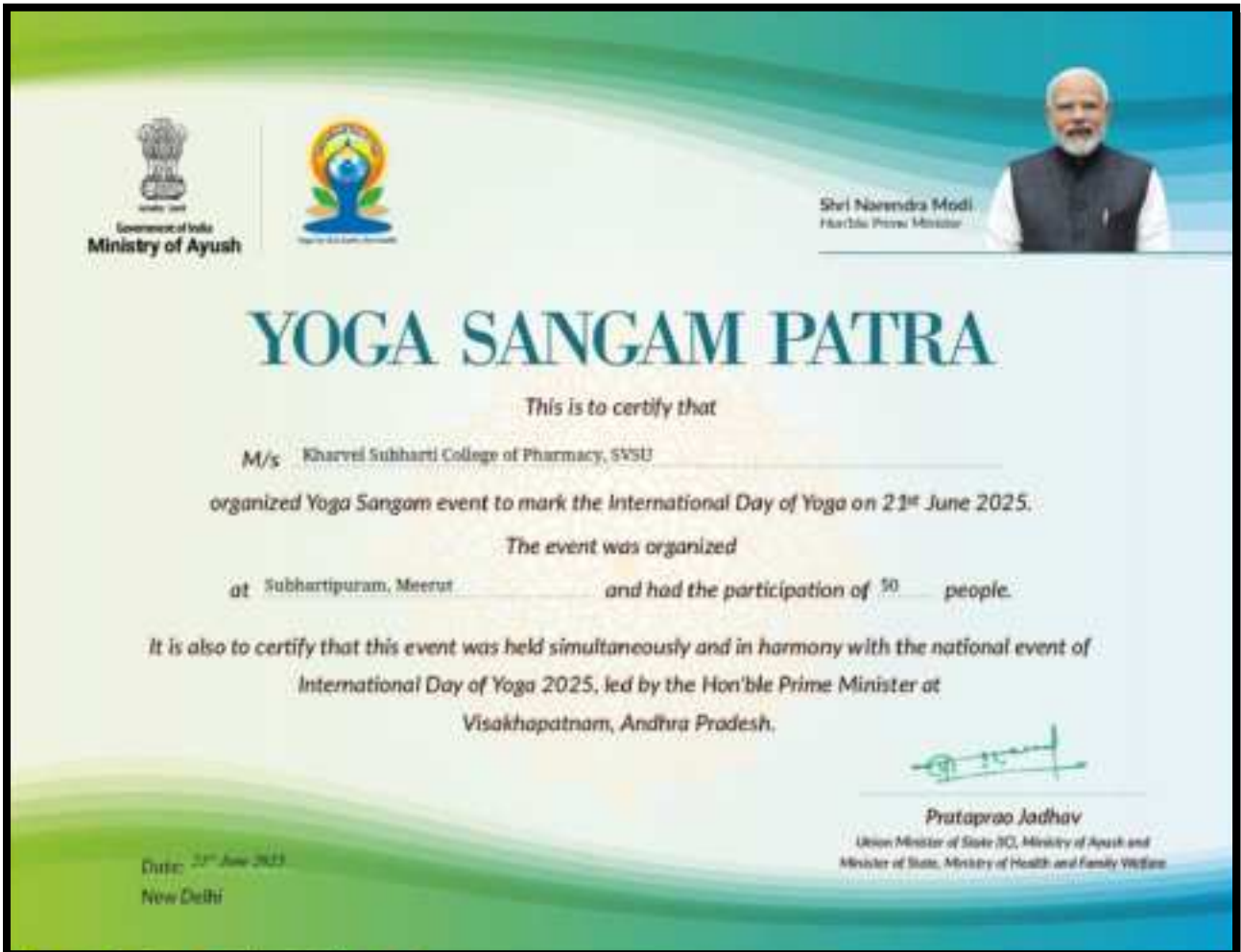

8. **Build Herd Immunity:** To protect entire communities, including those who cannot be vaccinated, by increasing overall immunization rates.

## Description

- On the occasion of **National Vaccination Day**, this activity is organized to emphasize the importance of immunization as a fundamental step toward achieving a healthy society. The program aims to spread awareness about the critical role vaccines play in preventing life-threatening diseases and ensuring the well-being of individuals across all age groups.
- The activity includes awareness rallies, health education sessions, and immunization camps conducted by healthcare professionals and volunteers. Informative talks are delivered on vaccination schedules, benefits of timely immunization, and the safety of vaccines. Posters, pamphlets, and interactive demonstrations are used to engage the community and dispel common myths and misconceptions related to vaccines.
- Special attention is given to children, pregnant women, and underserved populations to ensure they receive complete and timely immunization. The initiative also highlights the efforts of national immunization programs and encourages people to actively participate in vaccination drives.

## Outcome of the Activity

1. **Increased Public Awareness:** Participants gained better knowledge about the importance, safety, and benefits of vaccines.
2. **Improved Immunization Coverage:** More children and adults were motivated to complete their vaccination schedules.

3. **Reduction in Myths and Misconceptions:** Common fears and false beliefs about vaccination were addressed through education and interaction.
4. **Enhanced Community Participation:** Greater involvement of families, students, and local communities in immunization programs was observed.
5. **Better Access to Vaccination Services:** Health camps and outreach programs helped reach underserved and remote populations.
6. **Strengthened Preventive Healthcare Attitude:** People developed a positive attitude toward preventive healthcare and disease prevention.
7. **Support to National Health Programs:** The activity contributed to the success of government immunization initiatives.
8. **Progress toward Disease Control:** Increased vaccination uptake supports the reduction and possible elimination of vaccine-preventable diseases.

### **Analysis of Participant's Feedback**

- The feedback collected from participants indicates that the activity was highly impactful and well-received by the community. Most participants expressed that the program significantly improved their understanding of immunization and its role in preventing serious diseases. Awareness sessions and interactive discussions were particularly appreciated for simplifying complex information about vaccines.
- A large proportion of participants reported increased confidence in the safety and effectiveness of vaccines. Many misconceptions and fears, such as side effects and vaccine hesitancy, were effectively addressed during the sessions. This reflects the success of the activity in building trust toward immunization programs.
